RULES FOR THE ABS NOT-SO-SILENT AUCTION JULY 24, 2021

1. The seller/donor must fill out the form below for each item to be offered and submit the completed form to the Treasurer by July 16th so that silent auction bidding sheets can be prepared. The Treasurer will mark the form as to the date and time received. Up to 6 or 8 (depending on size) items will be accepted. It is understood that 50% of the winning bid goes to the Club and 50% to the seller/donor unless the seller/donor states on the form that it is a 100% donation to the club.

Items must be worth \$100.00 or more; consequently, the opening bid is \$100.00

- 2. If there is a reserve price as indicated below by the seller/donor, the bidding sheet will be marked as such. If there are no bids at or above the reserve price, the item will be returned to the seller/donor.
- 3. There will be short breaks throughout the auction so that bids can be checked or added to.
- 4. At about 1:00 PM, the Treasurer will pick up the sheets and after the tallying, announce the winners. The winners can then pay, or add the amount to the total for whatever else they have won during the auction.
